## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The majority of all the classrooms at Birch Grove Primary School are comprised of about 70% carpet in the A & B Wings and 95% carpet in the E-wing. This carpet is original to construction for A&B Wing in 1998 and 2002 for the E-wing. The carpet itself would probably not be the right product to use for the type of students being serviced and installation of VCT would consequently improve the sanitary, odor and air quality levels of the school. The cost to install VCT would be about \$4.50 per square foot in the following areas:

- 1. A and B wings- (16) classrooms- 630square foot rooms- 12,672 square feet
- 2. E Wing-(16) classrooms-896 square feet-14, 336 square feet

Total cost-\$121,536
