PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Tolland Intermediate School steel front door system is at the end of its useful life. There are issues with the door frames closing properly, improperly supported glass frames on the doors and fixed skylights, excessive rust at the base of the doors and sweeps, poorly functioning panic bar hardware and locks, and severe degradation for the glass adhesives and sealants around their frames. Proposal would include an aluminum style Kawneer or other commercial storefront style door frame system with the use of child-guard glass and new panic hardware. Access control devices would be new on that door so they would be re-used. Cost to implement this improvement for a 20' x 7'9" opening would be around \$25,000 for the types of products utilized.
