## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The current front sidewalk at Tolland Middle School is beginning to show severe to moderate areas of cracking and spalling. Furthermore the granite curbing is beginning to bulge out into the road area and will need to be re-packed. The current sidewalk is 380' long by 5' deep and comprised of concrete. To demolish the current concrete at approximately \$7 per square foot, re-pour at \$8.50 per square foot and to re-pack the curb at \$5,640 brings our total cost to-\$35,100
